# Burglary alert – Harwood area

There has been a recent spike in domestic burglaries in the Harwood area of Bolton. Properties with high performance vehicles parked outside and on driveways have been targeted.

Offenders have used the lock-snap method to gain entry to houses. They are breaking in overnight, usually in the early hours of the morning and are searching houses for vehicle keys. There have been six of these burglaries in Harwood since 5 March 2024.

To deter offenders, try anti snap locks on your property and consider increasing the security of your vehicle by using a steering lock or similar device which will be visible to potential car thieves.

# LOCK SNAPPING BURGLARIES

#### TOP TIPS ON STEPS YOU CAN TAKE TO PROTECT YOUR HOME

- 1 Look to upgrade euro cylinder locks on your external doors to an anti snap cylinder with a 3 star rating under TS 007 and/or the Sold Secure Diamond Standard.
- 2 Consider improving your door handles and by replacing them with a 2 star rating under TS 007. These locks can also protect against blow torch burglaries.
- 4 Use a reputable lock replacement company, preferably with Master Locksmiths Association accreditation. Visit www.locksmiths.co.uk for more information.
- 5 You may also be able to fit sash jammers to your doors, which can help to prevent burglaries. Check it won't invalidate any warranty on an existing door.
- 6 Consider fitting additional locks to patie and French doors to increase security.

# PROTECTING YOUR CAR

#### TOP TIPS ON STEPS YOU CAN TAKE TO PROTECT YOUR CAR.

- Always lock your vehicle, and never leave the engine running while unattended.
- 2 Keep car keys hidden and secured in a safe place, away from doors and windows. Consider purchasing a metal lock box or safe to store your keys in.
- 3 Keyless car theft, or 'relay theft', is when a device is used to fool the car into thinking the key is close by; this unlocks the car and starts the ignition. Protect your keyless car from being stolen by using a screened or signal-blocking pouch, such as a Faraday Pouch. The metal protective layer prevents the key signal from being intercepted.
- 3 Consider using a Sold Secure steering lock to deter thieves. A gear lever or clutch pedal security device can also give your car added protection.
- 4 If you can, keep your car in a garage. This prevents easy access, and also keeps it out of sight from any potential thieves.
- 6 If parking on the street, avoid parking in dark and secluded areas, and opt for a busy and well-lit street instead. Look for illuminated and staffed car parks, or those with a Park Mark safer parking award.

# North Neighbourhood Policing Priorities



Violent Crime / On street drug supply in Halliwell. Primarily in the School Hill and Brownlow fold areas. Officers are conducting high visibility patrolling at peak times to identify possible offenders and reassure the public. They will also be utilising their stop and search powers to detect offences and will arrest anyone found in possession of controlled drugs and / or weapons.



Vehicle crime, specifically thefts of vehicles and thefts of items from vehicles in the Astley Bridge and Halliwell areas. The offences are occurring mostly overnight on Blackburn Road and the surrounding area. Officers will be patrolling the area at peak times to detect and deter offenders and provide reassurance to the public.



Operation Portman / Op Limit – tackling speeding and traffic related offences on priority routes across the Bolton North area. The worst affected roads are Moss Bank Way, Halliwell Rd, Bury Rd and Blackburn Rd. Peak times, mid to late afternoon.

#### Burglaries.

How secure is your door? Burglars can break into your home by snapping the lock. Keep them at bay by upgrading your euro cylinder locks to an anti-snap cylinder with a TS007 3-star rating and/or the Sold Secure Diamond Standard.

#### Vehicle Crime.

Offenders are on the look -out for items they can easily steal from vehicles. Take care to keep vehicles secure when unattended. Do not leave anything of value in your vehicle overnight. If you have cctv at home, try to have this covering your vehicle when it is parked up, to deter offenders.
