TONGE & THE HAULGH OVERVIEW 3 domestic burglaries. 3 vehicle offences. Two domestic burglaries and one vehicle offence all occurred on Tonge Moor Road. One vehicle was stolen.

North Neighbourhood Policing Priorities



Violent Crime / On street drug supply in Halliwell. Primarily in the School Hill area, peak times in the late evenings. High visibility patrolling requested in the area with vehicle and person searches to prevent and detect offences.



Serious Acquisitive Crime [burglaries, vehicle thefts, thefts from vehicles] in Halliwell. Offences occurring midweek, overnight. Proactive policing is required at peak times.



Operation Portman / Op Limit – tackling speeding and traffic related offences on priority routes across the Bolton North area. The worst affected roads are Moss Bank Way, Halliwell Rd, Bury Rd and Blackburn Rd. Peak times, mid to late afternoon.

Burglaries.

How secure is your door? Burglars can break into your home by snapping the lock. Keep them at bay by upgrading your euro cylinder locks to an anti-snap cylinder with a TS007 3-star rating and/or the Sold Secure Diamond Standard.

Please ensure that when leaving your vehicle or house unattended, all windows and doors are locked. Avoid leaving keys on the inside of locks where the key could be reached if a window or glass pane is smashed and keep doors in good repair, so they cannot be easily forced. Also, please ensure all valuables are removed from display to remove the opportunity. Do not make it easy for the criminals. Keep your possessions safe.
